

One Fund for Kiribati

**Amendment No. 1 to the
Memorandum of Understanding
between
Participating UN Organizations,
and
the United Nations Development Programme
regarding the Operational Aspects of the One Fund for Kiribati**

WHEREAS, the Participating United Nations Organization signing this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to collectively as the “Participating UN Organizations”) have developed a **One-Fund for Kiribati** starting on 1 August 2009 and ending on 31 December 2012 (hereinafter referred to as the “Fund”), as may be amended from time to time, in support of the UNDAF Kiribati Implementation Plan (UNDAF-KIP) 2008-2012 as part of their respective development cooperation with the Government of **KIRIBATI**, and have agreed to establish a coordination mechanism (hereinafter referred to as the “Steering Committee”) to facilitate the effective and efficient collaboration between the Participating UN Organizations and the host Government (if applicable) for the implementation of the Fund;

WHEREAS, the Participating UN Organizations have agreed that they should adopt a coordinated approach to collaboration with donors who wish to support the implementation of the Fund and have developed a Terms of Reference to use as the basis for mobilising resources for the Fund, and have further agreed that they should offer donors the opportunity to contribute to the Fund and receive reports on the Fund through a single channel;

The Participating UN Organizations have now extended the Kiribati One Fund until 31 December 2014 in order to allow projects supporting the UNDAF Kiribati Implementation Plan (UNDAF-KIP) 2008-2012 to complete implementation of their activities.

The Memorandum of Understanding between the Participating UN Organizations, the Resident Coordinator and the United Nations Development Programme (acting as Administrative Agent of the Kiribati One Fund) is therefore modified as follows:

Preamble:

WHEREAS, the Participating United Nations Organization have developed a One-Fund for Kiribati, which has now been amended to end on 31 December 2014 (hereinafter referred to as the “Fund”), as may be amended from time to time, in support of the UNDAF Kiribati Implementation Plan (UNDAF-KIP) 2008-2012 as part of their respective development cooperation with the Government of **KIRIBATI**, as more fully described in the revised Terms of Reference of the Fund dated [16th November, 2012], (hereinafter referred to as the “TOR”), a copy of which is attached hereto as ANNEX A, and have agreed to establish a coordination mechanism (hereinafter referred to as the “Steering Committee”) to facilitate the effective and efficient collaboration between the Participating UN Organizations and the host Government (if applicable) for the implementation of the Fund;

All other terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding remain unchanged.
